2nd International ecoinvent Meeting, March 14, 2008 in Lausanne

On March 14, 2008, the 2nd International ecoinvent Meeting will be held in Lausanne, Switzerland. This one-day event will focus on the contents and applications of the new ecoinvent Data v2.0. Recognized international life cycle assessment experts from industry and academia will present how they make use of generic databases in their daily work. A representative from the Swiss Federal Office for the Environment will discuss the role of LCA in public policy making. The new database contents are explored in four parallel sessions focusing on biomass production, bio-energy and bio-materials, electronics, metals for ICT, petrochemical solvents, mechanical engineering, energy supply and new transport services. The event takes place back to back with the 34th LCA Discussion Forum on the topic "Life Cycle Assessment versus Carbon footprint?" (March 13, 2008). Since mid 2007 an extract of ecoinvent Data is implemented in the French online LCA tool "bilan produit". This tool was developed by the French Environmental Authority ADEME and is especially dedicated to be used by small and medium enterprises and by students. It allows for an initial assessment of the environmental impacts of a product. Until now, the tool has been downloaded more than 1'000 times. The international ecoinvent database published by the Swiss Centre for Life Cycle Inventories contains a lot of very useful downloadable cradle-to-gate LCI-results and unit processes representative of different countries and regions. Needed data is easily found with the search function on the ecoinvent homepage and received data has facilitated our work."
